



Dear Vendor:

The Black-n-Bluegrass Rollergirls 2012 skating season is coming to a close, but not before our Derby, Unbridled Tournament. We are extending one last chance to be a part of this fantastic season to our local artists and businesses by offering vendor booth space at our tournament. The tournament will happen on **October 20, 2012** from 11 AM until 10:30 PM at the **Bank of Kentucky Center** on the NKU campus, with vendors located on the concourse level. The tournament will feature the Black-n-Bluegrass Blackouts and Shiners, the Rollergirls of Central Kentucky, and the Vette City Roller Derby Girls, with tournament brackets starting at 11 AM, and the Final Showdown happening at 7 PM.

The tournament will offer a great way to connect with local roller derby leagues as well as our fans, and it will be open to the public the entire time for the same cost as a regular 3 hour bout. Promotions will be aimed primarily for the Final Showdown, but vendors are welcome to set up for either the entire event or the Showdown times for the same fee. Vendors will also be promoted on our Black-n-Bluegrass website with tournament promotions. - Vendor booth fee is \$25 and includes table, chairs, and admission for 2 people at will call
- DSL drop is available for an additional \$25 with advance notice
- Electricity for items on vendor booths can be provided with advance notice
- All day vendor check-in is 10 AM, Final Showdown vendor check-in is 5 PM
- Vendor break down must be completed by 10:30 PM
- Prohibited items include alcohol, tobacco, open food, stickers and balloons
- Tournament will have a total of 6 games (bouts), public admission is \$15
- Payment may be made via the donate button at <http://black-n-bluegrass.com/sponsors/> if made by **October 13**, or by check or cash before or on the day of the tournament
- Vendors will not be permitted to set up without both application and payment receipt by the day of the tournament
- Application deadline is **October 18**
